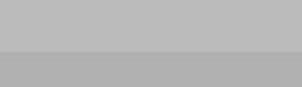
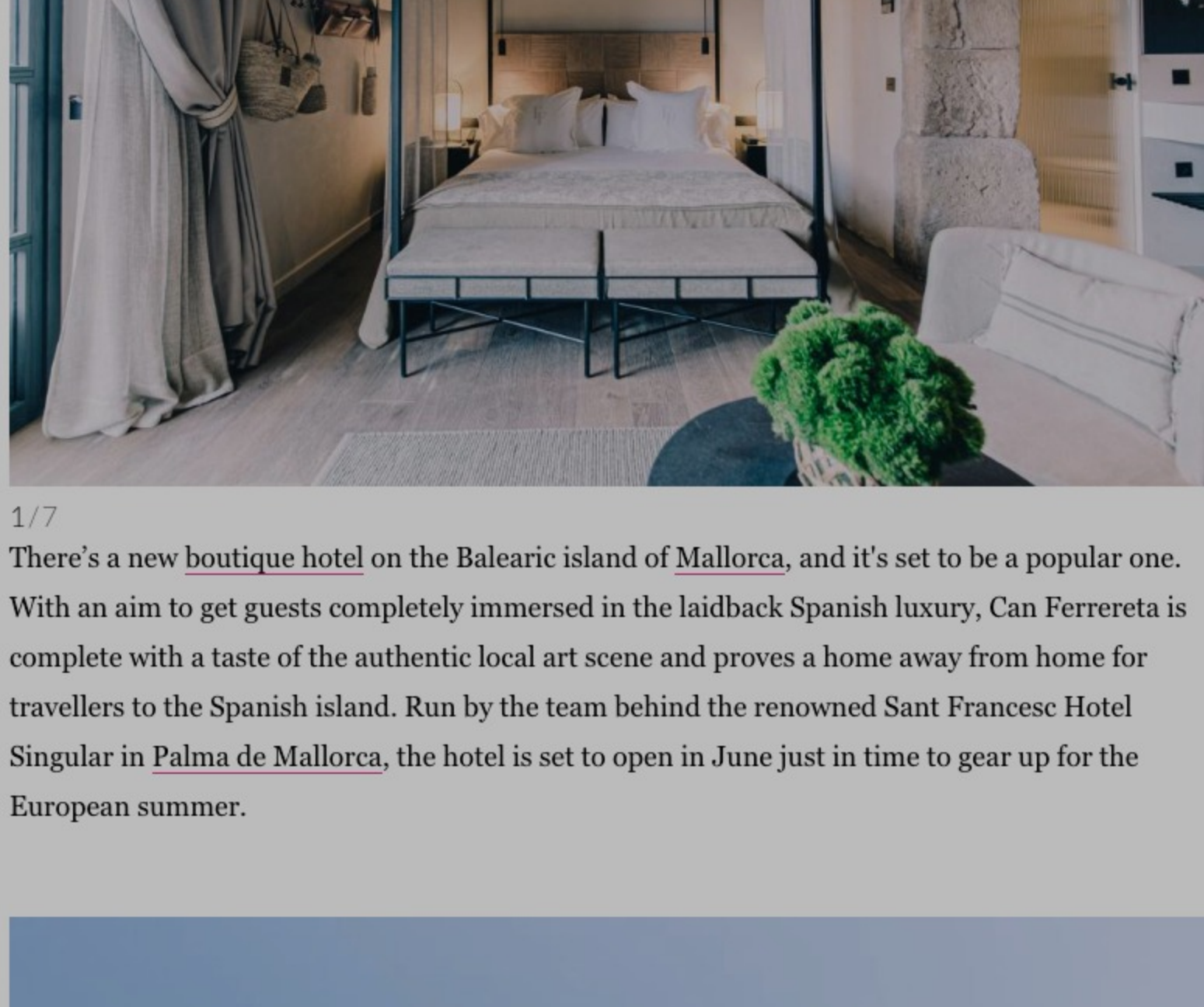


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Inside a new bohemian hotel in Mallorca

Rustic luxury within a 17th-century Spanish mansion.



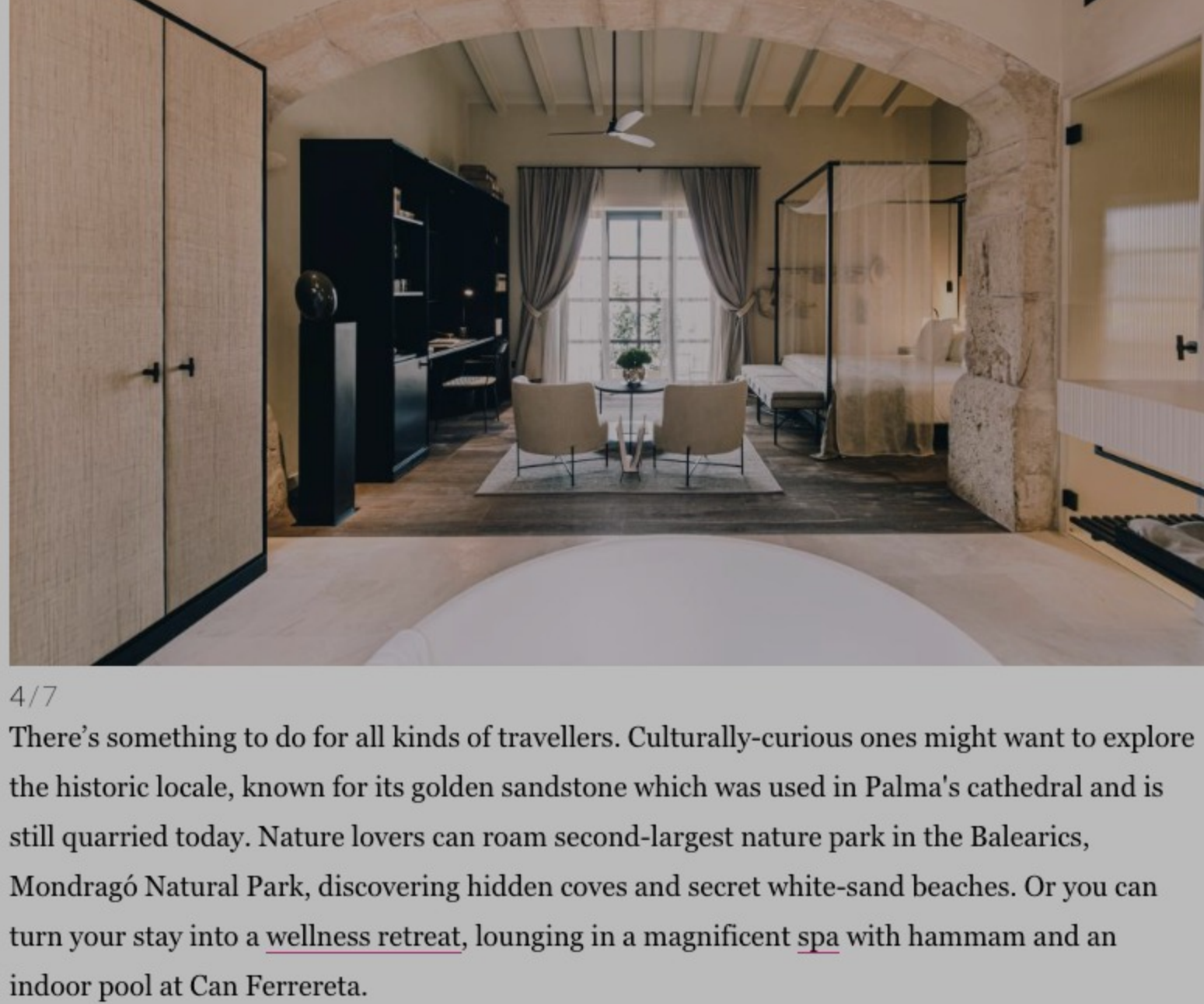
1/7 There's a new boutique hotel on the Balearic island of Mallorca, and it's set to be a popular one. With an aim to get guests completely immersed in the laidback Spanish luxury, Can Ferrereta is complete with a taste of the authentic local art scene and proves a home away from home for travellers to the Spanish island. Run by the team behind the renowned Sant Francesc Hotel Singular in Palma de Mallorca, the hotel is set to open in June just in time to gear up for the European summer.



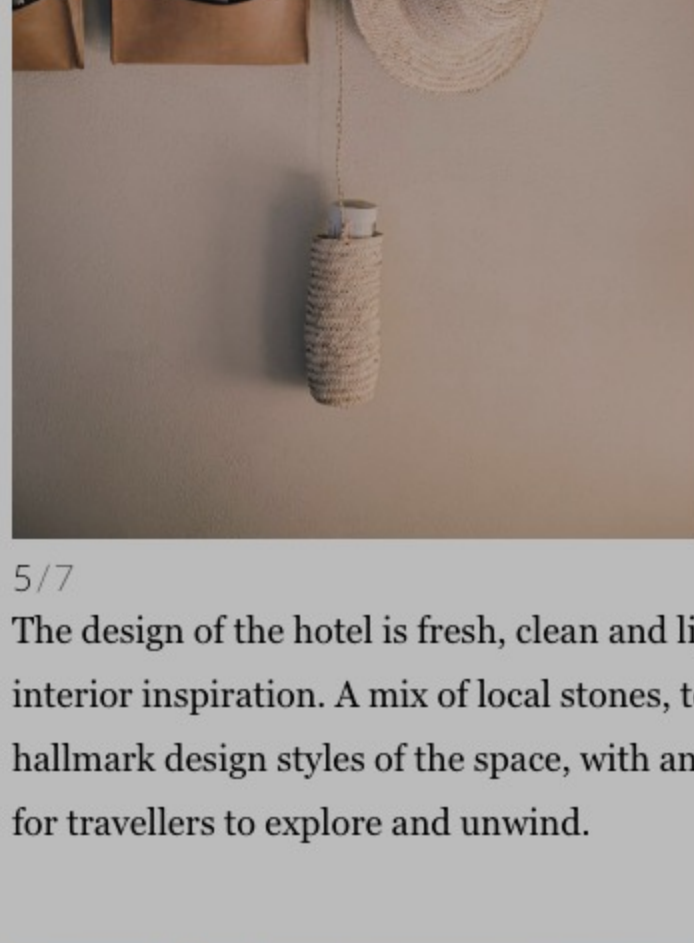
2/7 About 50 minutes south east from Palma, the dynamic capital of the island, Can Ferrereta is situated in a historic village called Santanyi. The quaint and picturesque town is a perfect setting for the newly-renovated 17th-century mansion, which was skillfully transformed into a 31-room hotel to offer a peaceful and chic refuge.



3/7 A team of creatives from Mallorcan-based Bastidas Architecture and Spanish design house WIT worked closely with the Soldevila-Ferrer family, the owners of the property, to preserve the building's authentic character, merging it with modern luxury. The rooms are spacious and airy, executed in a warm beige palette, bringing to mind a charmingly rustic summer house. The main suite boasts a private swimming pool and a delightful garden.



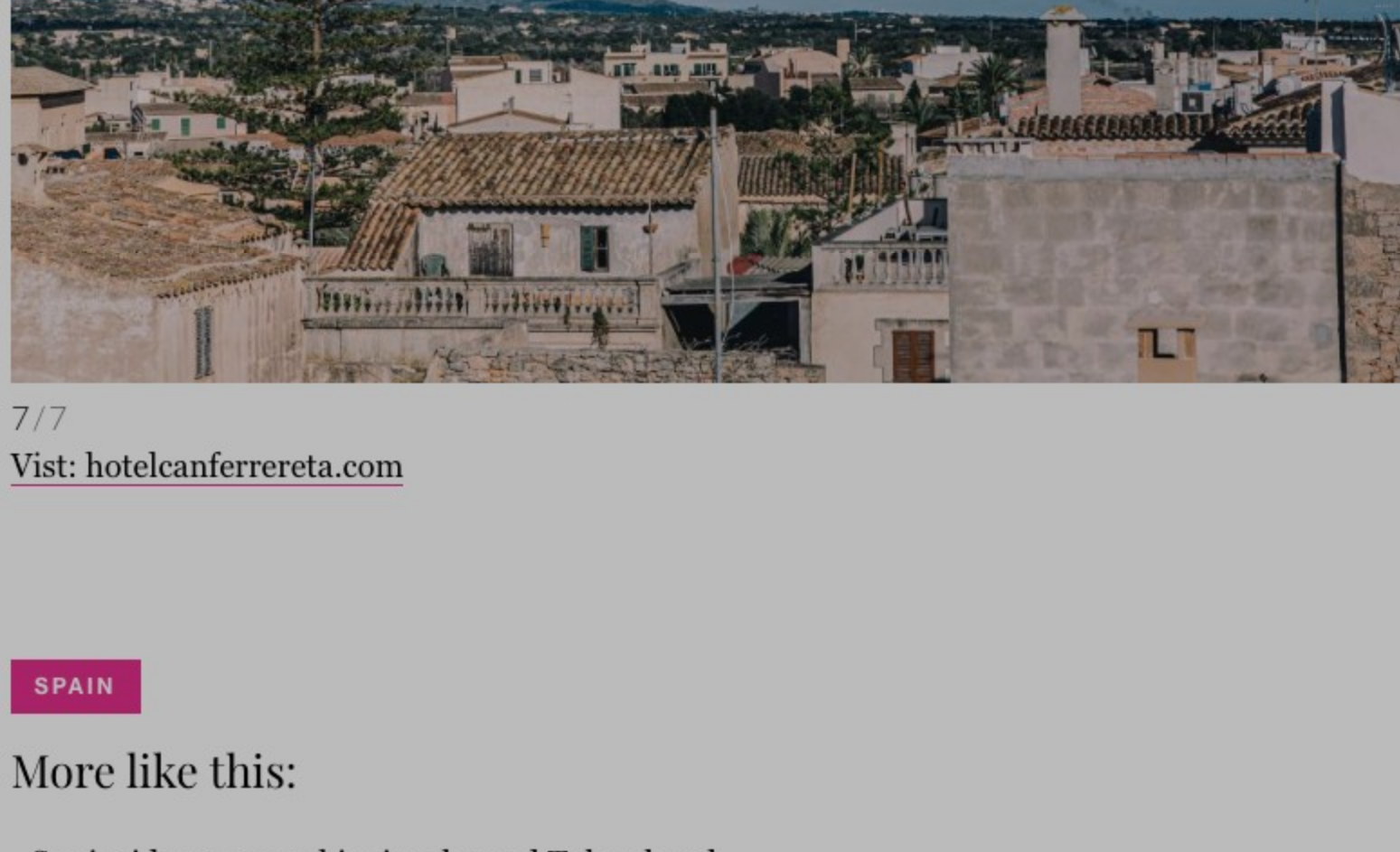
4/7 There's something to do for all kinds of travellers. Culturally-curious ones might want to explore the historic locale, known for its golden sandstone which was used in Palma's cathedral and is still quarried today. Nature lovers can roam second-largest nature park in the Balearics, Mondragó Natural Park, discovering hidden coves and secret white-sand beaches. Or you can turn your stay into a wellness retreat, lounging in a magnificent spa with hammam and an indoor pool at Can Ferrereta.



5/7 The design of the hotel is fresh, clean and light, drawing on the local coastal environment for its interior inspiration. A mix of local stones, textured fabrics and neutral colours make up the hallmark design styles of the space, with an inherent focus on providing a calm and tranquil spot for travellers to explore and unwind.



6/7 For a well-rounded Mallorca experience, spend a couple of nights in Palma to explore the cultural highlights and then head to off-the-grid Santanyi for ultimate tranquility.
